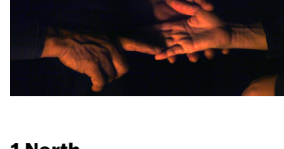

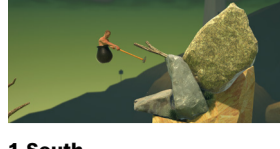

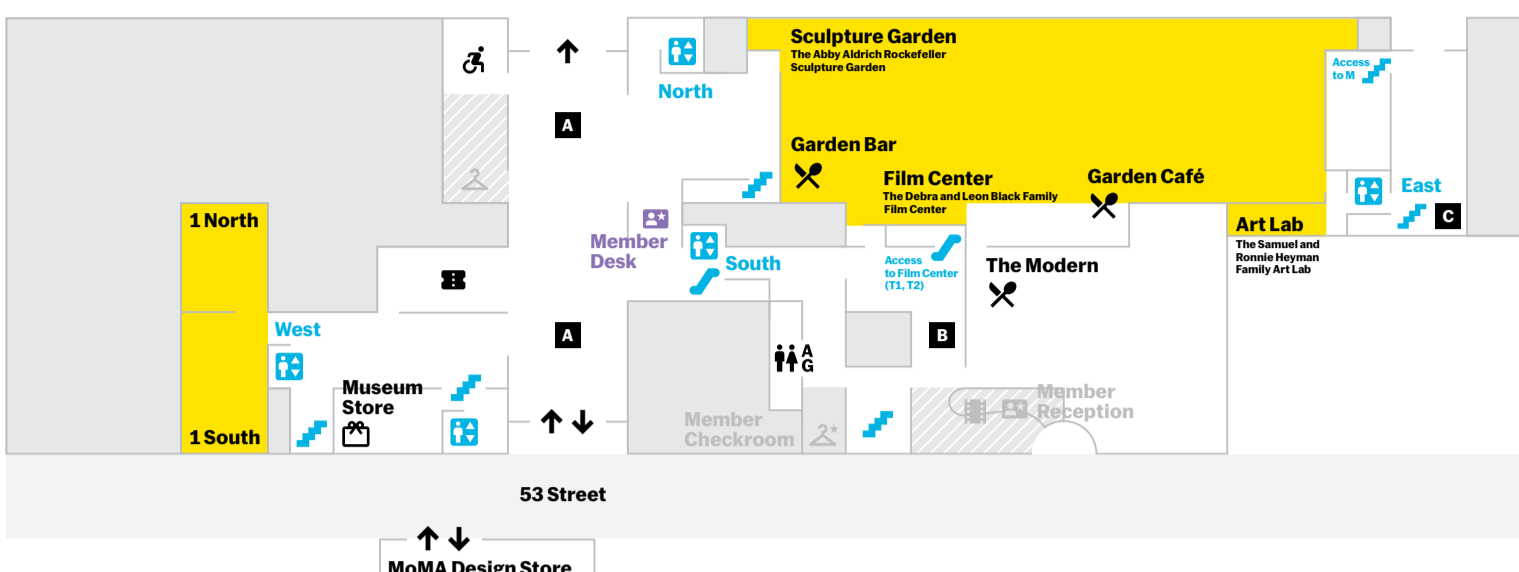

From the iconic @ sign to apps and video games, explore how interactive design shapes our lives.

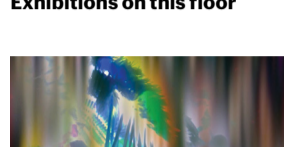

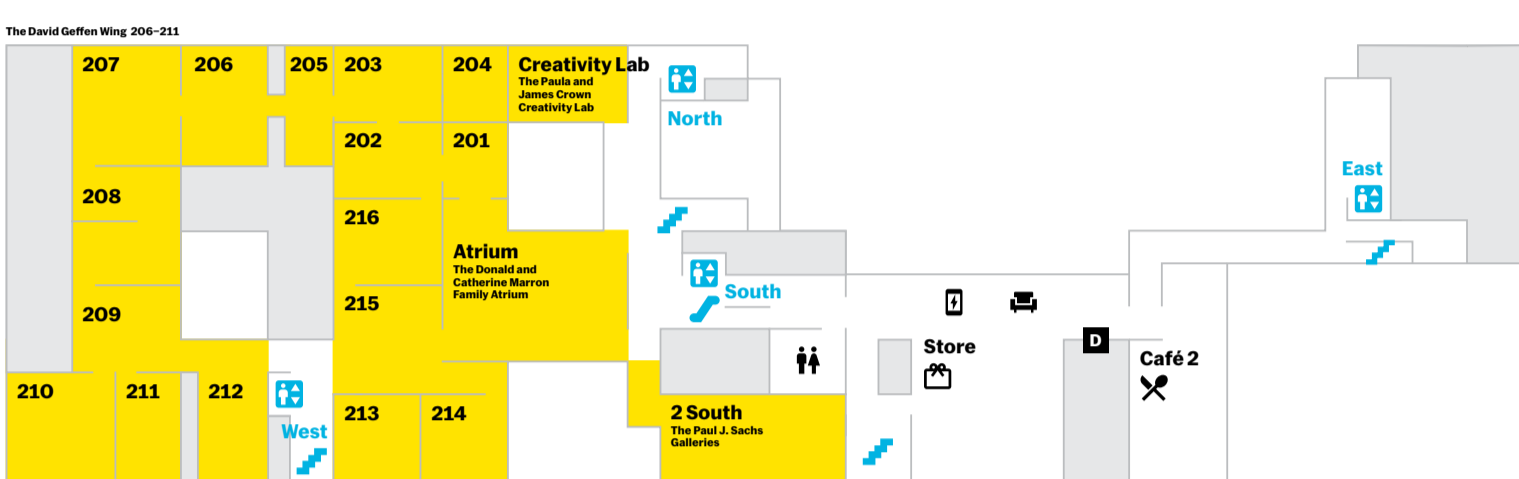


Marron Family Atrium

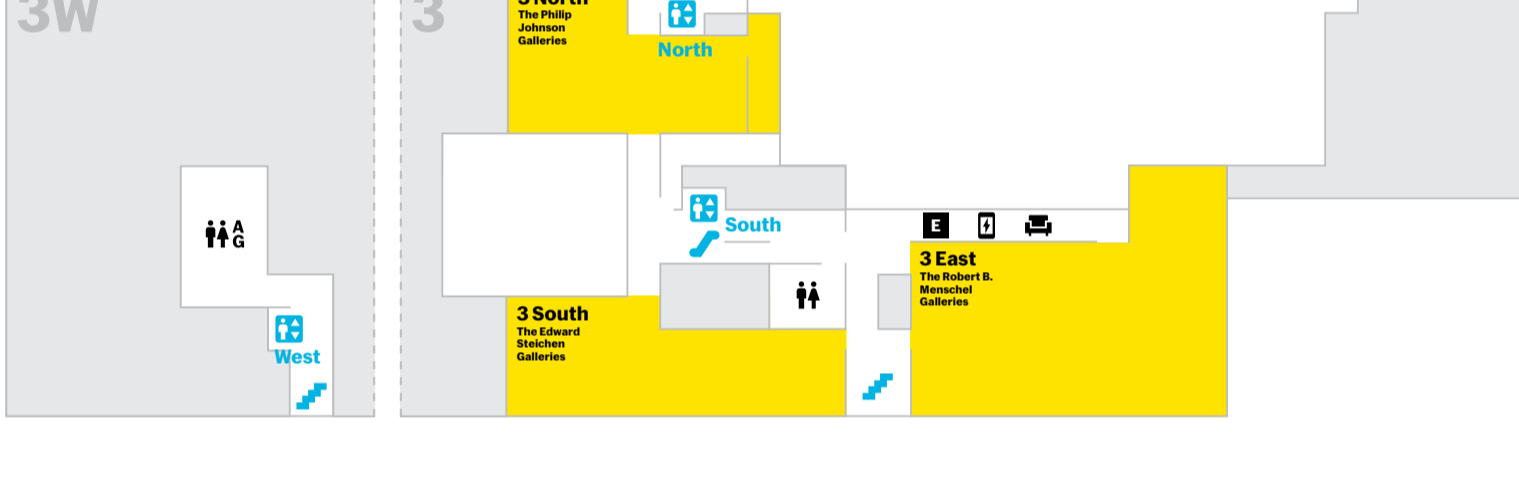


3 East, Menschel Galleries

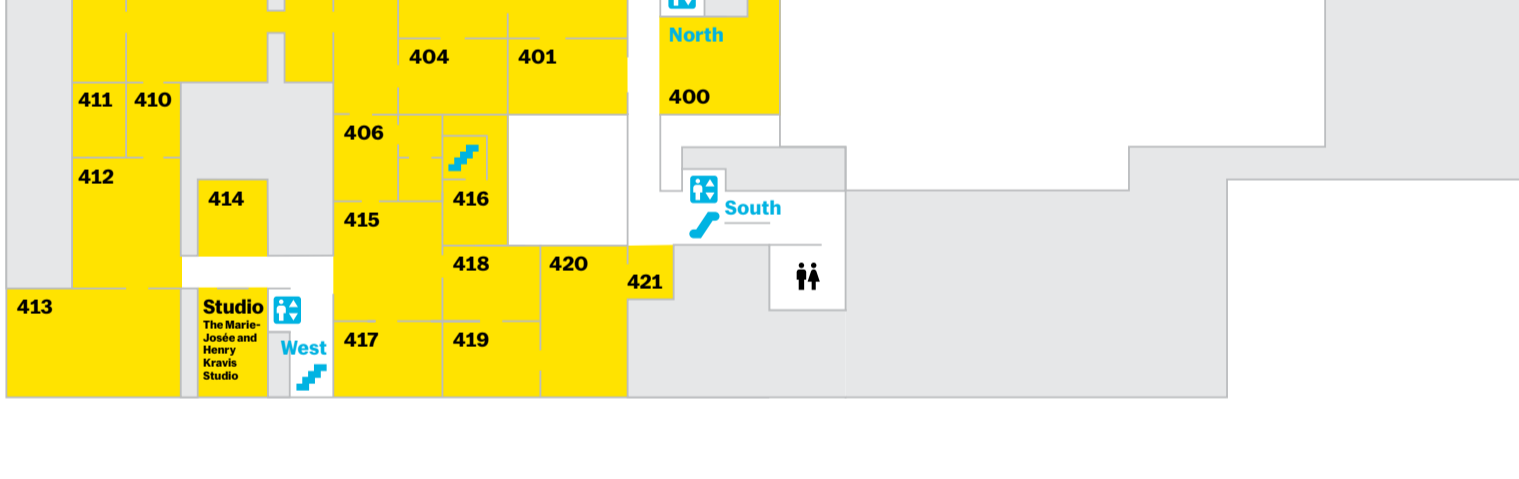

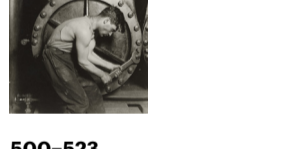
Kravis Studio

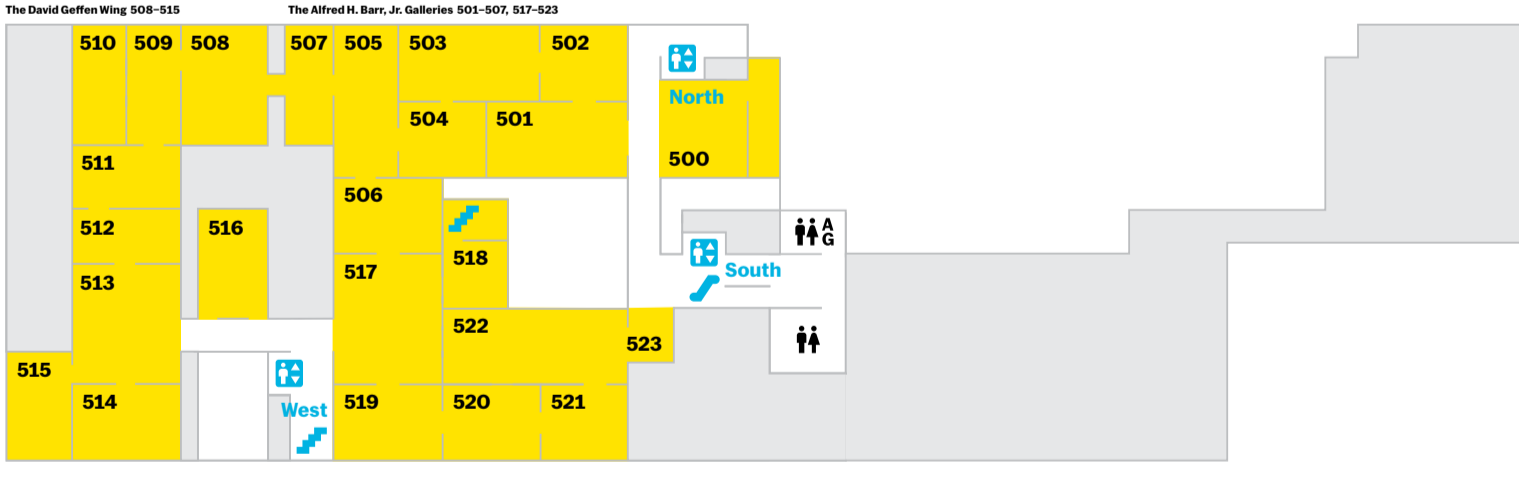

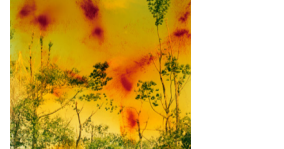

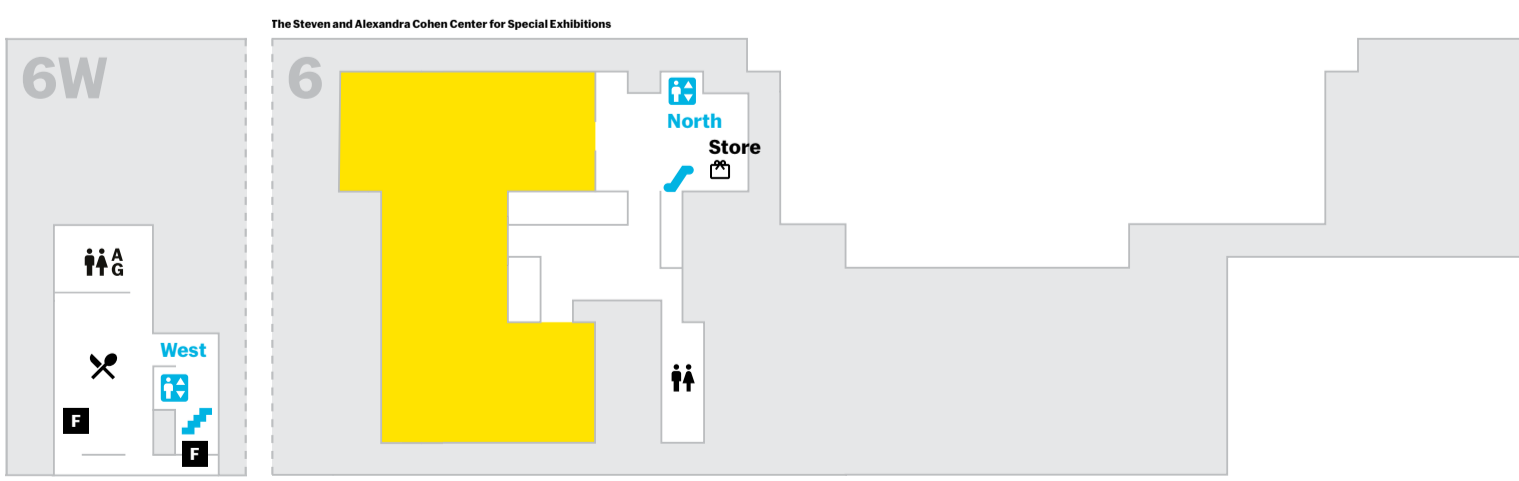
